

Blanc Auvernier AOC

Category white wine

Grape variety Chasselas

Region Auvernier, a mediaeval village on the

northern shores of Lake Neuchâtel

Alcohol content 11% alcohol volume

Colour pale yellow with silver tones, attractive

stream of miniature carbonic bubbles

Bouquet vine blossom, a touch of elder blossom,

mineral aroma

Palate highly typical of Chasselas, hints of citrus

fruit, slight vivacity because of its "sparkling"

nature

Serving temperature $8 \text{ to } 10^{\circ} \text{ C}$

May be laid down for 2 to 3 years

Ideal combination with food a thirst quenching wine, perfect as an

aperitif, but also excellent with all cheese dishes (fondue, raclette, quiches), as well as lake or river fish in melted butter
