



Non Filtré Auvernier AOC

Category	white wine
Grape variety	Chasselas
Region	Auvernier, a mediaeval village on the northern shores of Lake Neuchâtel (Switzerland)
Alcohol content	11% alcohol volume
Colour	pale greyish-yellow, cloudy since it has not been filtered
Bouquet	exotic aromas (citrus fruit, mango, banana), Chasselas blossom
Palate	exotic flavours, slight vivacity masked by the yeasts causing the cloudiness, very slightly bubbly
Serving temperature	8 to 10° C
May be laid down for	should be drunk within the year, particularly when extremely young (from January to June)
Ideal combination with food	perfect as an aperitif, also a flattering and thirst quenching wine that is a good accompaniment to Asian dishes
